Educator's Package One – Educational Standards

This program is correlated to the **Common Core Standards**. These classroom rules follow standards within the Speaking and Listening domain. Before beginning this program, be sure to establish norms for classroom discussions and have all students agree to follow them.

1. Listen actively to the speaker.
2. Raise your hand to respond. You can...
 - a. Agree with the speaker
 - b. Agree and build on their thoughts
 - c. Disagree and explain why, or
 - d. Ask clarifying questions

Speaking and Listening

Organizer – Name of book, Opinion, Reasons, Conclusion – 4 Square to write a paragraph.

Thinking Map – Circle map for character, Bubble map for character, Cause and Effect Flow Map.
